ITINERARY

Day 1| Singapore ✈️ Johannesburg

[Meals on board, Dinner]

Upon arrival at **OR Tambo International Airport** in **Johannesburg**, you will be warmly welcomed. For guests arriving early, there will be an insightful visit to the suburbs of **Fietas** and **Fordsburg**, where you'll gain a deeper understanding of the experiences of Muslims during apartheid. **Salah** will be performed at either **Greenside Masjid** or **Houghton Masjid**, depending on the schedule. In the evening, enjoy a delicious dinner and a brief orientation as you settle into your first night in the vibrant City of Gold. Overnight in Johannesburg.

Day 2 | Safari

[Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner]

Depart **Johannesburg** for the stunning **Pilanesberg Game Reserve**, where you'll spend the day on safari, exploring the region's incredible wildlife and natural fauna. On the return journey to **Johannesburg** (time permitting), there will be a stop at the magnificent **Nizamiye Masjid**, an Ottoman-styled mosque and the largest in the **Southern Hemisphere**. Overnight in Johannesburg.

Day 3 | Safari

[Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner]

Guests will visit the powerful and moving **Apartheid Museum** for an in-depth look at South Africa's dark and complex history. Afterwards, get up close with the **King of the Jungle** at the **Lion Park**, exploring its thrilling predator enclosures.

The rest of the day is reserved for leisure at the upscale **Sandton City Mall**, including a visit to the iconic **Nelson Mandela Square**. Overnight in Johannesburg.

Day 4 | Johannesburg → Cape down

[Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner]

Say farewell to **Johannesburg** as guests are transferred to the airport for their flight to **Cape Town**. Upon arrival and check-in, enjoy a visit to the breathtaking **Kirstenbosch Gardens**, the largest and most spectacular botanical gardens in **Africa**. Overnight in Cape Town.

Day 5 | Cape down 🚌 Robben island & the va waterfront 🚌 Cape town

[Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner]

After breakfast, guests are transported to the historic and infamous **Robben Island**, where **Nelson Mandela** and other leading anti-apartheid activists were imprisoned. Stand at the doorway of Mandela's former cell and reflect on the thoughts that may have crossed his mind during those years. The afternoon is reserved for leisure at the vibrant **V&A Waterfront**.

Day 6 | Cape down 🚌 Islamic heritage tour

[Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner]

We begin the day with a delightful breakfast before exploring the legacy of the early arrival of **Islam in South Africa**. No visit to **Cape Town** is complete without ascending the iconic **Table Mountain**, where you'll experience breathtaking views from this majestic landmark of the **Mother City**. The **Cape Islamic Tour** continues to the historic suburb of **District Six**, once home to a vibrant community forcibly removed during apartheid. From there, we head to the beautifully colourful neighborhood of **Bo Kaap**, where we visit the **Auwal Masjid (1794)**—the first established mosque in **South Africa**. Enjoy a walk through the area featuring striking **murals dedicated to Palestine**. We also pay our respects to **Tuan Guru** at the historic **Tana Baru Cemetery**, who was instrumental in founding the first masjid and memorably wrote the **Qur'an** entirely from memory. Overnight in Cape Town.

Day 7 | Cape peninsula

[Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner]

We begin a full day of exploration along the scenic peninsula of the iconic **Mother City**, passing through the coastal suburb of **Sea Point** en route to the charming fishing village of **Hout Bay** (meaning **Wood Bay**). A once-in-a-lifetime educational experience awaits at the **Boulders Penguin Colony**, where you'll encounter the endangered African penguins in one of the few land-based colonies in the world. Continuing along the peninsula, we arrive at the legendary **Cape Point**, located at the southeastern tip of **Africa**, renowned for its rich natural **flora and fauna**, dramatic cliffs, and pristine beaches. Our final stop brings us face-to-face with local residents of a different kind at the **Cape Point Ostrich Farm**, where you'll get a unique opportunity to meet these fascinating, speedy birds up close. Overnight in Cape Town.

Day 8 | Cape town

[Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner]

After breakfast, free day Enjoy a relaxed day at your own pace. Explore local markets, browse handmade crafts, or shop for unique souvenirs. Your guide can recommend the best spots for authentic South African goods.

Day 9 | Cape town ✈️ Singapore
