ITINERARY

Day 1 | Singapore → Kualanamu Airport → Pematangsiantar → Parapat → Samosir island

[Lunch, Dinner]

Morning arrival at **Kualanamu International Airport (KNO)**—no later than 10:00 AM—you'll be warmly welcomed by your local tour guide. Departing the airport, the journey continues toward **Parapat City**, with a scenic drive via the highway to **Pematangsiantar**, taking approximately 2 to 2.5 hours. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant in Siantar, then visit the peaceful **Vihara Avalokitesvara (Kwan Im Temple)**, a cultural and spiritual site. Next, explore Siantar's local products, such as peanut candy, peanut cookies, the iconic Roti Ganda, and a stop at **Kopi Kok Tong**—a beloved local coffee shop (personal expenses apply). Continue the journey with another scenic 2-hour drive to Parapat, passing through pine forests and **traditional villages**. Upon arrival in Parapat, cross the lake by ferry to **Samosir Island**. Afterward, check in at your hotel near the lake, and enjoy a relaxing dinner at the hotel restaurant.

Day 2 | Explore Samosir Island

[Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner]

After breakfast, begin your day with a visit to **Holbung Hill**, where you'll hike approximately **200 steps from the parking area** to reach a breathtaking panoramic view of **Lake Toba**—a perfect spot for photos and fresh air. Continue to **Sibeabea Hill** for a photo stop at the towering Jesus Christ statue, standing an impressive **61 meters from ground level**, making it the **tallest of its kind in the world**. Next, enjoy a short break and photo opportunity at the serene **Efrata Waterfall**, surrounded by lush greenery and cool mist. Lunch will be served at Saulina Restaurant, a lakeside venue offering relaxing views. On the return to your hotel, make a cultural stop at **Lumban Suhi-suhi Village**, where you can observe the traditional Batak weaving process of ulos cloth and visit a local ulos gallery to learn more or purchase authentic textiles. In the late afternoon, unwind and enjoy the sunset by the swimming pool before gathering for dinner.

Day 3 | Samosir Island Berastagi city

[Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner]

After breakfast at the hotel, check out and begin your day with a visit to **Ambarita Village**, well known for its historical **stone chairs and execution site of King Siallagan**, where you'll learn about the fascinating traditions and justice system of the ancient Batak people. On the way, you'll pass by local Batak souvenir shops, where you may browse for traditional handicrafts. Then, cross **Lake Toba by ferry** (based on the available schedule) and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant on the mainland. The journey continues toward **Berastagi**, with a short optional stop at a **local orange farm**, where you can **pick and enjoy fresh oranges** (at personal expense). Upon evening arrival in Berastagi city, you'll settle in and enjoy a delightful dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 4 | Berastagi Tour Medan sightseeing North Sumatra museum Tjong a fie mansion

[Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner]

After breakfast, start your day with a photo stop at **Shwedagon Pagoda** replica and explore the serene surroundings of **Lumbini Park**, located around the temple area. Then, embark on a scenic 2-hour drive to Medan. Upon arrival, enjoy a photo stop at Maimoon Palace, a historical icon of Medan, followed by sightseeing around **Medan's heritage and colonial-era buildings**. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant in the city. In the afternoon, deepen your understanding of the region with a visit to the **North Sumatra Museum**, where you'll learn more about the diverse cultures and history of North Sumatra Province. Next, explore the beautifully preserved **Tjong a Fie Mansion**, a 124-year-old heritage home from the Dutch colonial period, and hear the fascinating stories behind it. Afterward, enjoy a delicious dinner at a local restaurant in Medan. As a flavorful end to your day, you'll have the optional opportunity to visit **Bolang Durian**, where you can savor the famous Medan durian in the evening.

Day 5 | Shopping Kualanamu Airport Singapore

[Breakfast Lunch]

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and begin your day with a visit to several local specialty shops in Medan, perfect for picking up souvenirs and tasting regional delicacies. Stops include the famous Macehat Coffee, known for its rich local brews; **Bolu Meranti**, famous for its soft and flavorful layer cakes; Bika Ambon cake shops offering chewy, sweet delights; and a **marquisa syrup home industry**, where you can sample and purchase locally made **passion fruit syrup**. After shopping, enjoy your final lunch at a local restaurant in Medan before transferring to **Kualanamu International Airport (KNO)** back to **Singapore**
